New Jersey Interior Designer Elected National President ASID

The American Society of Interior Designers (ASID), the world's largest professional association of interior designers with headquarters in Washington, D.C., announces the election of Suzan Globus, FASID, Globus Design Associates, Red Bank, to President. Ms. Globus, a member of the New Jersey Chapter of ASID, is the first New Jersey-based interior designer to hold this office.

“As professional designers pull their chairs up to the table to join the other members of the design team on projects around the globe, they bring a wealth of knowledge that they have received through ASID about the interior built environment and its effect on human beings,” Globus said. “I am honored to execute the strategic plan to deliver that support to our 38,000 practitioner, industry and student members.”

Globus, an award winning interior designer, is principal of Globus Design Associates in Red Bank, N.J., which provides design consultation for public, educational and museum libraries, and select residential projects. A Fellow of ASID, the interior designer writes and speaks about interior design solutions and practice issues to clients and design practitioners around the country. Recent projects include the restoration and redesign of the Newark Public Library lobby and the 100,000 square foot expansion of the Ocean County Library, Toms River, N.J.

Globus was recently appointed by the Governor to sit on the state's first Interior Design Examination and Evaluation Committee established to regulate the practice of interior design in New Jersey. She is an NJ Certified Interior Designer. She sits on the Advisory Board for the Interior Design program at Brookdale Community College in Lincroft, where she is a former adjunct instructor. She a past president of the New Jersey ASID chapter and the New Jersey Coalition for Interior Design Legislation, which spearheaded the recent passage of New Jersey's Interior Design Certification Act. Globus also is a recipient of New Jersey ASID's Medalist Award for outstanding contributions to the chapter and the interior design profession.
